Since the opening of the Newberg, Oregon, property awarded **LEED Gold** and routinely finding itself on top hotel lists from Conde Nast Traveler and Travel and Leisure, The Allison Inn & Spa has put a focus on living up to its sustainable reputation, reducing water usage 37 percent and utility costs 48 percent.
